MasterFILE Premier™

Database designed specifically for public libraries, MasterFILE Premier™ provides full text coverage for nearly 1,900 periodicals covering general reference, business, health, education, general science, multicultural issues and much more. This database also contains full text for more than 160 reference books, 88,000 biographies, 60,000 primary source documents and an Image Collection of 91,000 photos, maps and flags.

MasterFILE Premier now offers PDF backfiles (as far back as 1975) for key publications including American Libraries, Crisis (the New), Foreign Affairs, History Today, Judaism, Library Journal, National Review and Natural History.

ERIC provides full text of more than 2,200 digests along with references for additional information and citations and abstracts from over 980 educational and education-related journals.
